

# **START UP PROCESS -**

Add **Metal Gone (Whole Bottle)** or **EZ SPA START (Half bottle)** to Remove metals, phosphates, scaling carbonates and organic debris.

# When Water Gets 90 Degrees or Higher :

When adjusting Water chemistry **ALWAYS** balance Alkalinity first, then pH, then sanitizer.

Add pH Increaser (Spa Up) or pH Decreaser (Spa Down) as needed to balance Alkalinity and pH.

NOTE: With initial fill ups you will most likely have extremely High pH and Alkalinity once your spa has reached the set temperature. Check Alkalinity and pH with a test strip. Add 1-3 cap fulls of Spa Down to lower alkalinity, until you see a color shift on the test strips. Once you see a color shift then use the recommended dosage on the bottle for your spa to balance alkalinity and pH

#### Total Alkalinity 80-120 ppm

**PH** 7.2-7.6

### (DO NOT PROCEED UNTIL PH & ALK LEVELS ARE CORRECT)

Add **SPA 56** at a dose of 1/2 oz per 100 gallons.

Add **EZ SPA TOTAL CARE** at a dose of 1oz per 100 gallons. For spas using ozone, mineral purifiers or salt. Add 1/2oz per 100 gallons.

### AFTER 24-48 HOURS RINSE THE CARTRIDGE FILTER(s)

## WEEKLY:

Add SPA 56 at a dose of 1 Teaspoon at the end of each day the spa is used. (Reduce to ½ Teaspoon if tub is being used daily) If spa is not being used, Spa 56 should be added a minimum of 1x /week at a dosage of 2-3 Tablespoons.

Test water with a test strip. Adjust PH as Needed. (Should only take a tablespoon or two) Make sure this level is correct before proceeding.

Add **EZ SPA TOTAL CARE** at a dose of 1oz per 100 gallons. For spas using ozone, mineral purifiers or salt add only 1/2oz per 100 gallons.

Rinse CARTRIDGE FILTER(s)

## **Additional Water Care:**

Water Changes are recommended every 3-6 months, dependant on usage. Daily users will need to do water changes every 3-4 months. People with average usage patterns (3-4 times per week), will be changing their water every 4-6 months.

When refilling your spa, fill through the filter housing to avoid air locks in the pumps. If your home has a water softener make sure your outside spigots are on bypass. The spa water needs to have calcium levels of at least 150-250ppm. Using softened water will cause the water to become corrosive, resulting in damage to the spas components.

Filter(s) should be replaced with new ones every 12-18 months.
